Handy tip! We gave

the children a 2oz

measuring spoon so

flour, 2 butter and 1

they measured 3

sugar!

#### Ingredients:

- 175q/6oz plain flour
- 100g/4oz butter
- 50q/2oz caster sugar

## Method:

- 1. Preheat oven to 150'C
- 2. Cream butter and sugar
- 3. Mix in the flour until it forms a ball
- 4. Roll out the dough until 5mm thick
- 5. Cut out your biscuit shapes
- 6. Bake for 25 minutes or until golden brown
- 7. When cool, share them with your friends & family
